- ❖ A Poster which should be displayed on all club's notice boards
- Entry forms for both the Men's & Ladies tournament have the CLOSING DATE 8th of FEBRUARY.
- Placing of teams is done on a "first come, first serve" basis and it is therefore important that teams enter directly to Boland Bowls and all entries, together with proof of payment, must be submitted to Bräsler van Schoor at overbergbowlscomps@gmail.com BUT ALSO to Club secretaries by no later than 8 FEBRUARY. Club Secretaries to keep record and send all entries with proof of payment to District Secretaries no later than 9 FEBRUARY.
- ❖ District Secretaries are to please submit the final Summary sheets for entries and badges, which are attached, to Bräsler by the 10 February 2022.
- ❖ Teams to pay their own District for both entrance fees and the number of badges required. After the closing date District to pay the money over to Boland accompanied by summary sheets.
- ❖ Proof of payments for the entry fees (**number of teams x R600**) are to accompany the individual entry forms or together with your summary sheet. Please advise all entrants to put a valid reference when making payment. **Club and skip's name**.

- ❖ Please ensure that BSA membership numbers are included on the entry forms, i.e., no country members, associate or social members or other subsidiary class of members may participate. **Dual members** may however, with agreement of the club concerned, play for any club of which he/she is a member providing the clubs are in the same district.
- ❖ The entry amount includes 5 numbers on a raffle Sheet (5 tickets per team). A set of new Bowls are up for grabs for each Tournament (Men's & Ladies). Should any club wish to sell additional lists, please inform our office and we will get additional sheets to you.
- ❖ The Handbook will NOT be printed but will be available on the website for anyone to view.
 We aim to use this as the platform for clubs to advertise activities around the tournament at their clubs so that players can plan their tournament days to the fullest. Clubs wishing to use this opportunity should contact Pierre Paul at pierrepaul@sonicmail.co.za by 8
 February 2023 for costs and inclusion into the first release of the handbook on 21 February (this will be without the draws). Further information on this will be sent to clubs soon.

- ❖ URGENT NOTICE: Advise ALL Skips (also noted on the entry form) that Branded clothing in direct opposition to our Sponsor Personal Trust -, may not be worn. If unsure, before teams have kit made up, please check with Pierre Paul. As in previous years, there is an All Cape sponsors branded shirt available for order directly with the suppliers and information about these will be sent under separate cover.
- ❖ Badges are to be pre-ordered. Skips are to please indicate on the entry form as to how many badges are required at R35 per badge. No additional badges will be available to purchase once the tournament commences. District secretaries must keep a summary of orders and submit together with entry summary no later than 10 February 2023.
- Zoning: Each section will play at one venue only during the round robin stage. All entrants are requested to indicate their preferred venue for play in the round robin stage of the Tournament from 1 4. Placing will be done on a first come, first serve basis and it is therefore important to indicate in order, their preferred choices. The venues are: Overberg Area(LADIES & MEN): Caledon(1 section), Hermanus(3 sections), Kleinmond(2 sections), Franskraal(1 section) and Bredasdorp(1 section-Men Only). Winelands Area(MEN ONLY): Worcester(1 section), Tulbagh(1 section) and Ceres(1 section) and Paarl(1 section).
- **❖** Ladies' tournament will be played in Overberg Area only.
- ❖ We will endeavour to place all teams at their preferred venue, but once a venue is filled, placing will be done on 2nd preferred venue etc. Preference will also be given to teams from outside Boland for zoning. Hosting clubs will be limited to one home side per Section.
- Playoffs to be played at Worcester BC (men only) and Hermanus BC with semi-finals and final to be played at Headquarters, which is Hermanus BC.
