

I am retired from corporate after almost 40 years of retail advertising, marketing and strategic planning and therefor have an eye for detail and value good communications and planning.




LINSTON MANUELS - Transformation



Highlights as a player - winning most District competitions, including the Open Singles and recently the Open Fours with my buddies from Caledon! Proudest achievement -Winning Gold with the Open side in 2014.

I was asked to take over the position as competition secretary for Overberg 4 or 5 years ago. I was reluctant but decided to take on the task. A couple years after that I was asked to also take on that role in Boland. I was appointed Convener of Veteran Selectors for a few years which I have recently stepped down from to focus more on my duties as Boland Exco member, but also myself as a player.

I tend to see things from a player's perspective and how to improve the player's experience. Looking at different formats used around the world and being open for change, implementing these changes to improve and grow the game. Using new technology, social media and being creative with it. FUN FACTS ABOUT LAWN BOWLS

Lawn bowls is the only sport where it is not uncommon at club level to see players in their seventies or eighties compete against players in their teens or twenties, and yet still be able to win. We've compiled 7 interesting facts about one of the world's most challenging games.

LAWN BOWLS FUN FACT 1: WHAT DOES 'JACK' ACTUALLY MEAN?

The meaning of the word is subject to debate. Some say it means something which is cast or thrown, because of the Latin word 'jactus'. Others say it means something small or inferior. Other, more colloquial names for the jack include the white, the kitty or the sweetie, the Cot in Federation Bowls (EBF), and, in the case of crown green bowls, the block.

LAWN BOWLS FUN FACT 2: SHAKESPEARE WAS AN ENTHUSIAST

Shakespeare was apparently a member of a bowling club, and his plays are littered with references to the sport. Cymbeline, which was written around 1610, contains one of the first recorded mentions of the jack – "Was there ever man had such luck! When I kissed the jack, upon an up-cast to be hit away."

LAWN BOWLS FUN FACT 3: A ROYAL FAVOURITE

England's King James I was a fan of lawn bowls. He once issued a publication called The Book of Sports, in which he condemned football and golf but encouraged bowls.

LAWN BOWLS FUN FACT 4: A 16TH CENTURY DISTRACTION

King Henry VIII was a lawn bowler. However, he banned the game for those who were not wealthy because "Bowyes, Fletchers, Stringers and Arrowhead makers" were spending more time at recreational events such as bowls instead of practising their trades.

LAWN BOWLS FUN FACT 5: BOWLS FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE BLIND

A modified version of bowls can be played by people who are blind, and many blind bowlers are extremely skilful. A string is run out down the centre of the lane and wherever the jack lands it is moved across to the string and the length is called out by a sighted marker. When the bowls are rolled, their distance from and position in relation to the jack is also called out. This allows the bowler to adjust their aim and the force of their throw.

LAWN BOWLS FUN FACT 6: AN ANCIENT EGYPTIAN GAME

Many bowls historians believe that the game developed from the Egyptians. One of their pastimes was to play skittles with round stones. Artefacts of this game were found in tombs dating 5,000 B.C.

LAWN BOWLS FUN FACT 7: TASSIE BEGINNINGS

The Beach Tavern at Sandy Bay in Tasmania was the venue for the first recorded game of bowls in Australia. It was played in 1845.



BOWLS HIGHLIGHT AT THE WEST COAST

A local highlight to close off this year was the West Coast bowls league tournament. This is a very popular bowls competition and teams from Darling, Yzerfontein, Langebaanweg, Langebaan (2) to Velddrif entered to determine the overall winner.

The West Coast league tournament consists of teams of three mixed gender veteran players. Clubs enter 2 teams of 3 club members, with designated reserves. To encourage smaller clubs to participate, they are allowed to join up with another smaller club to make up 2 teams. This was not necessary this year as this competition has become very popular since it was started some 8 years ago.

The teams play against each other each Thursday over a 6 week period and during this time a fantastic spirit of comradery develops between the team members. The competition is high and winners are only determined at the end. This form of play demands that each player performs at their best to consistently achieve positive results. This means that it is very interesting to watch and the final drew many supporters and visitors.

Each week the venue changes to another club with the final traditionally held at the LCE bowls club in Langebaan. Some 60 players participated in the tournament and 6 clubs entered teams. The team compete twice on the day with each game lasting 18 ends. The score is made of a point for each end won and additional points if a game is won. There are also bonus points available which makes the competition even more interesting. The total points won are accumulated over 5 weeks and on the finals day the number 1 and 2 play against each other, third against fourth etc. to determine the overall winning club.

A further incentive is the prize money that is shared with the top 4 teams in the tournament. Next year the sponsor will be Suzuki and it is likely that the sponsorship will exceed R10 000.

The finals and prize giving was held on the 2 greens of Langebaan Country Estate bowls club. "This is the first time on the West Coast that so many players competed together in one location", said Edie Bremner, the president of LCE.

"We are going from strength to strength as this tournament grows in popularity and next year there will be even more entries as the qualification age will be 55 years and above" according to Leon Meyer, the president of West Coast Bowls.

LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

It is noted that eventually Boland Management has adopted the policy of players over the age of 60yo being moved up to the Veterans division regarding selection for Inter Districts.

Although it is not yet compulsory for the over 60yo to qualify only for selection for the Veteran teams, it is a step in the right direction.

The benefits of players of the over 60yo being migrating to the veteran's ranks are, inter alia, the following:

- 1. With the inclusion of top players like Stoffel Lambrechts, Mark Beviss-Challinor & Callie vd Merwe, the Men's Veteran sides should do very well at Inter Districts, thereby restoring Boland to be powerful contenders for winning gold each year.
- 2. Good, experienced players like Leon Beer and MP Olivier have again made themselves available for selection for the Veteran teams for ID.
- 3. More importantly, it would open the way for the promising younger players to obtain exposure in the Open sides at ID level.
- 4. For the past number of years, the Men's Open sides have been clogged up with over 60yo players and this has discouraged the younger players from putting in the extra time and effort required to perform at ID in the Open division.
- 5. In turn, the younger generation of bowlers who make it to the ID level would encourage their friends to take up bowls seriously instead of just partaking in the annual business leagues.

It is trusted that Boland Management will in due course take the next step forward and make it obligatory for players reaching 60yo to be available for selection for ID for the Veterans teams only.
