## SPEL- VOORWAARDES

## CARRYING A BOWL TO THE HEAD

Law 17.2.1.

A bowl is not rendered dead if it is carried by a player when he goes up to inspect the head. However, keep in mind that should you decide to take your bowl up to the head, don't put it down in the head, and better still, get into the habit of leaving your bowl on the mat when going up to inspect the head.

What would be the result should you happen to drop your bowl while inspecting the head?

## LOTING VIR AANVANG VAN SPEL

Reël 5.2.1. bepaal dat daar geloot moet word voor aanvang van spel deur 'n muntstuk op te skiet. **NOU ONTSTAAN DIE VRAAG WAAROM NOU?** "... ons het nog altyd die bal geskop, wat is verkeerd daarmee?"

Eerstens is rolbal seker een van die enigste sportsoorte waar 'n bal geskop word. In geen ander sport skop die spelers 'n bal of gooi hulle toerusting rond om te bepaal wie die loot wen nie.

Behalwe dat dit uiters onprofessioneel is, gebeur dit in baie gevalle dat die bal regop tot stilstand kom en dan weer geskop moet word.

Gebruik 'n muntstuk wat in jou rolbalsak gehou word ten einde te bepaal wie wen die loot.

## POSSESSION OF THE RINK

Law 13

As soon as each bowl comes to rest, possession of the rink will transfer to the opposing player or team after allowing time for marking a toucher as soon as it comes to rest.

This means you, as the skip or third, **MAY NOT** jump into the head in order to tell your player that he has just drawn the shot.

You may convey this information once the next bowl has come to rest and it is again your player/team who has to deliver a bowl.

# RUGBY WORLD CUP 2019

Don Walton was Rugby Springbok no. 397 who played his first international match in Springs against France in 1964 when he was 25. He received eight caps for South Africa.

His position was hooker and he was the first hooker at international level to throw the ball in the line out (previously done by the winger). Don played against New Zealand, Australia, Ireland and Scotland, and his last match was against England at Twickenham in 1969.

The Springbok team at that time was amateur and the “daily allowance” the players received was enough to buy 1½ beers.

Don played his provincial rugby for Natal. He was a member of the Glenwood Old Boys Club. He never played for the first team at Glenwood School as he was only 16 in his matric year.
